

## Kingdom Business Alliance (KBA)

Notes - September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2008

**I. Significance:** Every person is searching for a simple formula to successful, fulfilled life; finding our true purpose and living it.

- Greatest life tragedy: not death but life without purpose
- Greatest life failure: being successful in wrong assignment
- Greatest Challenge: knowing what to do

Success: the issue of how efficiently and effectively we use our time (Time is the currency of life/everything is after our time.)

Jesus Christ, the most effective person that ever lived, reduced life to simple pursuits: 1. Place called Heaven, and 2. Concept of righteousness. **God's priority = Kingdom First**

Introduced a Heavenly kingdom to an earthly realm, restoring the lost Kingdom of Heaven on earth. (MT 6:17 Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is near)

If we take care of God's priority - His Kingdom - He will take care of ours.

MT 6:33 "Seek First the Kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added unto you...."

Luke 10:10 "The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of God has been given to you"

**II. Kingdom: God's government, makes us citizens.** Jesus turned world upside down. Can't save ourselves nor provide for our own needs.

- Everything belongs to the King, we own nothing. Kingdom resources are unlimited.
- Maslow's hierarchy turned upside-down: everything man pursues outside the Kingdom of Heaven is motivated by drive to meet personal needs.
- Jesus taught to not focus on possessions rather focus on our position in Him.
- King's favor, not earned but granted as desired by King. "added = did not work for"
- Seek King's Presence not things. Cease looking to ourselves but to our Heavenly Father-who is our true source.
- Presence: righteousness attracts God because He is righteous.

**III. Righteousness:** Gives us access to all rights, resources and privileges of citizenship.

- Foundation for our exercising the authority of God is our relationship with God
- The Lord looks at the heart – pure motive
- Corporate righteousness (Family, Business, Community/Nation)
- Today's problems: not Kingdom lack, but a release and distribution issue (MT6:30 "O' you of little faith")
- When "a king will reign in righteousness and rulers will rule with justice" IS 32:1 then >>>>>

2COR9:10 "Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness."

Hebrews 5:13-14 "Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness. But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil".
